





Protect Your Bike from Theft!

Write Down Your Bike's Information

- Record the make, model, serial number, and colour of your bike, and take pictures of it so that in the event of a theft police can identify it as yours
- The serial number is usually stamped onto the frame where it connects to the pedals
- Save all of this information in a safe place that is easily accessible - or better yet save it to your mobile device.

Report Theft

- If your bicycle is stolen, your best chance at recovery is to immediately report it to the Calgary Police Service at (403) 266-1234 or at www.calgarypolice.ca
- Reporting the theft assists police in catching and arresting thieves, and also enables them to identify problem areas to better focus resources on

Secure Your Bicycle

- Always lock up your bike no matter how secure the area or how long you'll be out of sight
- If possible, lock your bike in an area of high visibility
- Be sure to lock your bike to an immovable object preferably a bike rack - that is anchored to the ground
- Use a quality lock that secures both the frame and the wheels.
 A local bike shop will be able to give you advice on the best type of lock for your uses
