- Complete minor maintenance and repairs as required; including, but not limited to, belt & filter replacement, lamp replacement, housekeeping of common areas, washroom and plumbing repair work, etc

Qualifications:

- Must hold at minimum, a 5th Class Power Engineering Certificate
- 2-5 years building maintenance experience in a Commercial Office environment
- Experience in Preventive Maintenance and BMS Programs
- Basic Knowledge of electrical and Life Safety Systems and principles
- Fully trained with 2-5 years in BMS systems "Apogee 600", central plant controls, variable speed systems, and computer tenant request systems.

- Must be able to climb ladders frequently; working at a height
- Must be able to walk long distances on slippery uneven surfaces continuously
