



- BOMA Calgary remained engaged with City Council and Administration throughout municipal budget deliberations voicing concerns of our members and reiterating the importance of a tax share shift alongside our industry partners at NAIOP Calgary, Calgary Chamber of Commerce, and the Calgary Downtown Association.
- •BOMA Calgary's Public Safety Committee and Government Affairs Committees joined forces to develop a survey that collects information around downtown safety and its ongoing impact on our members. Information from the survey will be used to inform decision makers about potential support programs.
- BOMA Calgary is a key stakeholder as the City and Province move forward on the Green Line LRT project. Together with industry partners successfully advocated for improvements to the final plan and have keep keeping our members appraised on the impacts of ongoing construction.
- BOMA Calgary is leading a broad industry coalition to seek greater transparency and information sharing between energy utilities and building owners and managers.



- BOMA Calgary was a key stakeholder in development of the revamped Real Estate Council of Alberta (RECA), and forcefully advocated for more fair representation for the commercial sector. BOMA Calgary has also remained engaged through this process to provide feedback on new rules and structures.
- BOMA Calgary holds a seat at the City of Calgary's Climate Panel and continues to to work with the City of Calgary provide industry feedback to the City's initiatives, programs and strategic direction.
- BOMA Calgary has been working with BOMA Edmonton to provide feedback on updating BIA Taxation in Alberta.
- BOMA Calgary and Members of its Government Affairs Committee remain engaged with the City of Calgary on the Stephen Avenue revitalization project plan.






2022/23 BOMA BUILDING GUIDE
